

What to Bring to Boy Scout Summer Camp

Use this handy checklist as you pack for camp. Marking your items with your name, and troop number is also helpful.

Just as you use this checklist to pack to go to camp, take a few moments and use this checklist to pack before leaving camp.

CLOTHING:

- Class A Scout Uniform
- OA Sash if you are an OA member
- Sweatshirt
- Poncho/Raingear
- T-shirts (red Troop 95 tee and a couple others)
- Underwear
- Comfortable, closed toe shoes
- Socks
- Shorts
- Swim Trunks
- Pajamas or sweats to sleep in
- Hat or visor
- Watch

CAMP NECESSITIES:

- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Day pack
- Flashlight or Headlamp with fresh batteries
- Refillable water bottle or hydration pack

TOILET KIT:

- First Aid Kit
- Toothbrush & paste
- Comb/brush
- Soap/Shampoo

- Kleenex
- Towel
- Insect repellent
- Sunblock/Chapstick
- Any prescription medicines

SUGGESTED ITEMS:

- Sunglasses
- Fishing gear
- Disposable camera
- Compass
- Spending money

MERIT BADGE ITEMS:

- Scout Handbook
- Pen/Pencil/ Notepad
- Unfinished partial merit badge cards
- Merit badge pamphlets
- Money for merit badges that require fees

*****DO NOT bring ANY electronic devices, expensive cameras, radios or other such items to camp. One-time use cameras with your name and address written on them are suggested.***
